2. Alterations and repair work determined by the mechanical official to be of a minor nature.
3. Business, Mercantile, and Storage building having HVAC equipment only, with one fire area and not more than 3,500 square feet.
4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00

Instructions for completing application

General: Mechanical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Mechanical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection call the building department with the job location and permit number.

*Does not include registration fee

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A permit will be cancelled when no inspections are requested and conducted within six months of the date of issuance or the date of a previous inspection.

CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
