



CITY OF TAYLOR—RECYCLING DROP-OFF SITE INSTRUCTIONS



Beginning July 2nd, curbside recycling will be replaced with the following recyclable drop-off sites:

- D.P.W. Building, 25605 Northline Road, Monday-Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday, 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Taylor Hills Transfer Station/Compost Site, 16300 Racho Road, Monday-Saturday, 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- William Ford Senior Activity Center, 6750 Troy, Monday-Friday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Dumpsters will be set up for individual disposal of the items listed below. The dumpsters will be labeled accordingly. Please follow the instructions carefully to ensure a successful program!

CARDBOARD RECYCLING: (Racho Rd. site only!) GLASS:

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Cardboard boxes (i.e. pop containers, cereal boxes, etc.)
Corrugated cardboard (i.e. pizza boxes)

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

No wax liners from cereal boxes
No plastic bags
No waxed coated boxes



PLASTICS:

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Plastic items marked HDPE (2) and PETE (1)
Plastic grocery shopping bags

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

All other plastics

METALS:

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Tin cans
Aluminum cans



ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Clear and brown glass
Soda bottles
Beer bottles
Juice bottles
Ketchup bottles
Wine & Liquor bottles
Food containers

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Green glass
Mirrors
Automobile windshields
Light bulbs
Clay flower pots
Laboratory glass and crystal
Ceramic cups, plates and bottle tops
Window glass
Heat resistant ovenware
Opaque/milk glass, drinking glass



NEWSPAPER DISPOSAL:

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Newspapers and all inserts
Glossy magazines and catalogues only
Telephone books
