ORDINANCE NO. 2020 -

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO TEMPORARILY PERMIT CITY
OFFICIALS TO WAIVE STRICT COMPLIANCE WITH VARIOUS
CITY OF TAYLOR CODES AND ORDINANCES TO FACILITATE
RECOVERY FROM COVID-19 PANDEMIC

THE CITY OF TAYLOR ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. A new Temporary Emergency Ordinance be put in place to permit City Officials to waive strict compliance with various City Codes and Ordinances in order to assist and facilitate businesses and residents in recovery from the COVID-19 Pandemic. The Code of Ordinances is hereby temporarily amended to allow for the following:

TEMPORARY EMERGENCY COVID19 RECOVERY ORDINANCE

Officials of the City of Taylor 's Planning Department and Building Department may, under certain circumstances, waive strict compliance with various City Codes and Ordinances relating to use of outdoor property, event lengths, signage, ordinances relating to distancing and current recovery, etc., at their discretion, for the safety and protection of residents and businesses and to facilitate economic recovery from the COVID-19 Pandemic. Such City Officials are also authorized to develop and implement temporary guidelines and requirements consistent with the intent of this temporary emergency ordinance.

This temporary emergency ordinance will expire on November 30, 2020.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion of this ordinance, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. SAVINGS. All proceedings pending and all rights and liabilities existing, acquired or incurred at the time this ordinance takes effect are saved and may be consummated according to the law in force when they are commenced.

SECTION 4. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby temporarily and repealed only to the extent necessary to give this ordinance full force and effect.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be effective upon the passage by the City Council and the publication of the Ordinance in accordance with the Charter of the City of Taylor and the statutes of the State of Michigan.
